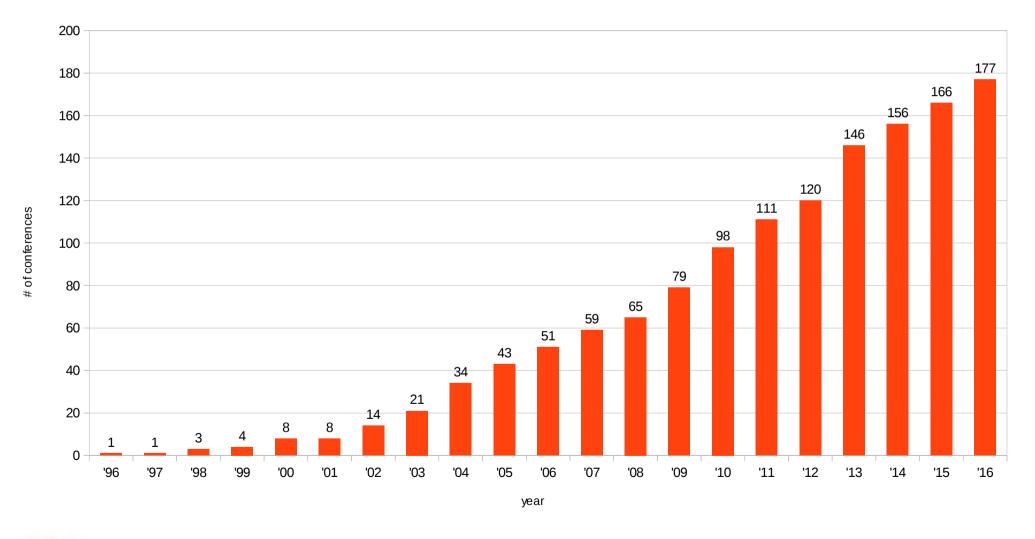


Published conferences
